## Egypt Immigration and Customs Checklist

- Passport is valid and will not expire within 6-months of your arrival.
- You have applied for an [e-Visa](#) , a consular VISA, or are prepared to obtain a VISA on arrival.
  - If applying for a VISA upon arrival, you have the equivalent of \$25 USD in local cash on hand to pay for the VISA.
  - If applying for a VISA upon arrival, you have two blank passport pages for the VISA.
- You have purchased travel insurance to show proof of medical insurance upon arrival
- You have reviewed the Egypt Immunization Recommendations.
- You have reviewed the Egypt Customs Restrictions.
  - You have not packed firearms, narcotics, cotton, or poultry items.
  - You are bringing in the equivalent of under \$200 USD of commercial items.
  - You are not bringing in over the allowed amount of tobacco, alcohol, or perfume\cologne items.
- You have reviewed the Egypt Currency Requirements.
  - You are bringing in under \$5,000 in Egyptian Pounds and under \$10,000 in USD

### **COVID-19 Requirements:**

- You have a negative COVID-19 PCR test, taken at a maximum of **72 hours** before your flight departure time. If you are traveling from Japan, China, Thailand, North America, South America, Canada, London Heathrow, Paris, and Frankfurt, the test can be taken a maximum of **96 hours** before your flight departure time.
  - The PCR Test is from an Accredited Lab
  - The PCR Test is in English and Arabic
  - The PCR Test is in printed form (digital results will not be accepted)
