South Africa Immigration and Customs Checklist

- Passport is valid and will not expire within 30-days of your arrival.
- You have applied for a VISA if necessary (see below).
 - No VISA necessary for travelers visiting from the United States, Canada, or the Schengen Area of the European Union if you are staying for less than 90-days.
- You have purchased travel insurance.
- You have reviewed the South Africa Immunization Recommendations.
- You have reviewed the South Africa Customs Restrictions.
 - You have no narcotics and other controlled substances.
 - You aren't bringing pornography.
 - You have not packed weaponry, explosives and fireworks etc.
 - You have no poisonous chemical and biological substances and other health endangering substances.
 - You don't have cigarettes with a mass of more than 2 kilogram per 1000 units.
 - You haven't packed any counterfeit goods.
 - You don't have any goods that break copyrights laws
 - You don't have any prison-made and penitentiary-made goods.
- You have reviewed the South Africa Currency Requirements.
 - You do not have any Kruger Coins or over 25,000 South African Rand (ZAR)

COVID-19 Requirements:

You are able to meet one of the following COVID-19 entry requirements:

- You have a verifiable COVID-19 vaccination certificate with QR Code.
- You have a valid certificate of a negative PCR COVID-19 test obtained not more than 72 hours before the date of departure.
- You have a valid certificate of a negative antigen COVID-19 test that was within 48-hours of the date of your departure.
- You have a valid certificate of a positive PCR COVID-19 test that is recognized by the World Health Organization for a test date that is within 90-days of your date of arrival and more than 10 days prior to the date of arrival, along with a signed letter from your health care provider (in your country of origin) stating that you are fully recovered from COVID-19 and not experiencing any new symptoms.
