Argentina Immigration and Customs Checklist

	Passport is valid on the date you will be arriving in Argentina.
	If you aren't from a <u>VISA exempt country</u> : You have <u>applied for your tourist VISA</u> to enter
	Argentina.
	You have purchased travel insurance.
	You have reviewed the Argentina Immunization Recommendations .
	You have your Yellow Fever Vaccination record (if you are traveling to a high-risk area in
	Argentina).
	You have reviewed the Argentina Customs Restrictions.
	 You have no narcotics and other controlled substances.
	 You are not carrying guns, knives, weapons, or ammunition.
	You do not have any explosives.
	 You don't have any meat or meat products of any kind.
	 You aren't carrying any milk or dairy products.
	 You don't have any fresh fruit or vegetables.
	 You don't have any trees, plants, or plant products.
	 You haven't packed a new computer or a television.
	 You aren't carrying any soil of any kind.
	 You don't have any counterfeit money and goods.
	 You haven't packed any pornographic material.
	 You are carrying less than 2 liters of alcoholic beverages *.
	 You have less than 400 cigarettes or 50 cigars *.
	 You are carrying less than 5kg of food *.
	* The allowed amount is half the listed total if you are from Bolivia, Brazil, Chile,
	Paraguay, Uruguay, or an Argentinean resident returning after more than a year away.
	You have reviewed the Argentina Currency Restrictions and Considerations.
	• If you have more than 10,000 USD or equivalent, you are prepared to declare that
	money upon entering Argentina.

You have at least two credit cards with no foreign transaction fees to use while in

Argentina.
