	Passport is valid and will be valid 3 months after your trip is complete.
	If you aren't from a VISA-exempt country, then you have applied for a tourist VISA.
	If you reside outside of the EU's Schengen Area, you have applied for an ETIAS Visa.
	You have reviewed the <u>Italy Immunization Recommendations</u> .
	You only have medication for personal use and it is in valid prescription containers.
	Your Non-commercial personal goods are less than 430 Euros value (if entering by air or by sea).
	Your Non-commercial personal goods are less than 300 Euros value (if entering by land).
	Your Non-commercial personal goods are less than 150 Euros value (for those 15-years old or
	younger).
	You have less than 200 cigarettes, 100 cigarillos, 50 cigars, or 250 g of smoking tobacco (if
	entering by air or by sea).
	You have less than 40 cigarettes, 20 cigarillos, 10 cigars, or 50 g of smoking tobacco (if entering
	by land).
	You don't have more than 1 liter of alcohol exceeding 22% volume, 2 liters under 22% volume of
	alcohol, 4 liters of wine, or 16 liters of beer.
	You aren't traveling with any meat or milk products.
	You aren't traveling with any products made from endangered species.
	Any powdered milk for babies in your possession doesn't need to be refrigerated before opening
	and is brand-packaged with the original seal (quantity must not exceed the weight of 10 kg
	originating from Croatia, Færøer Islands, Greenland, and Iceland, and of 2 kg if originating in
	other countries).
	You have reviewed <u>Italy's Currency Restrictions</u> .
